1/4 c. bottled Italian salad dressing 3-3 1/2 lbs. chicken breasts 1 slightly beaten egg 2 T. water 1/2 c. grated Parmesan cheese 1/3 c. fine dry bread crumbs 2 T. dried parsley 1/2 tsp. salt 1/2 tsp. paprika 1/8 tsp. pepper

Preheat oven to 350°. Pour salad dressing into dish. Add chicken, turning to coat on all sides. Cover and refrigerate 4 hours, occasionally tilting dish and spooning dressing over chicken. Drain chicken, reserving dressing. Combine egg and water. In plastic bag, combine cheese, crumbs, parsley, salt, paprika and pepper. Dip chicken in egg mixture, then shake, a few pieces at a time, in crumbs mixture to coat. Place chicken in 9x12 baking dish. Spoon remaining dressing over chicken pieces. Bake 45-50 minutes or until tender and brown.



RECIPE: Cheddar Cheese Grits with Italian Sausage

4 cups chicken stock • 1 cup stone ground grits not quick or instant
1/4 cup butter • 1/4 cup shredded Parmesan
1 cup shredded cheddar cheese
1 Tablespoon olive oil • 1 pound sweet Italian sausages
2 Tablespoons minced onion
2 cloves garlic, minced
2 cups chopped fresh tomatoes about 1 1/2 lbs
1/2 teaspoon kosher salt • 1/2 teaspoon Pepper
2 Tablespoons chopped Basil optional

In a medium saucepan, bring the chicken stock to a boil. Add grits in a slow stream, whisking the whole time. Reduce heat, cover and simmer stirring frequently until the grits are very thick, about 20 minutes.

Remove from heat and stir in butter and cheese, season to taste.

Meanwhile, in a medium skillet, heat the oil over MEDIUM LOW HEAT and add sausages. Turn occasionally and cook until nearly done, about 10 minutes. Add onion and garlic to the pan and cook for 2 minutes.

Then add tomatoes to the pan, season with salt and pepper and cook until sausage is done (Internal temperature of 165 degrees) and tomatoes are tender, about 5-10 minutes. Serve grits topped with sausages and tomatoes. Sprinkle with basil and serve.



Gelebrate Oktoberfest in Loretto



The city of Loretto, Tenn., celebrates Oktoberfest each year. The first Oktoberfest goes back to a horse race in Germany in the year 1810. The occasion was the marriage of Crown Prince Ludwig to Princess Therese of Sachsen-Hildburg-hausen. Around 40,000 people attended the event in Munich, Germany.

This celebration soon developed into a harvest festival, and as time passed, it became more and more extravagant. Beer was first served in 1818; shows and rides appeared at the same time. Since then, the Munich Oktoberfest has become an international event with millions of visitors attending. Germans in other countries have held on to the tradition of celebrating Oktoberfest in whatever country of the world they find themselves. The community of Loretto has a strong German heritage. Around 1870, a Catholic priest, Father Heuser with the Cincinnati Homestead Association, organized two mission parishes in Loretto and St. Joseph, Tenn. He brought with him members of the Precious Blood Missionary Order of Nuns and Brothers, who assisted in establishing the parish building that served as both church and school. Before this, Loretto bore the name of Glenrock. The Catholic settlers changed the name to Loretto in 1871 in honor of Our Lady of Loretto, invoking her to protect and preserve Loretto from disaster. Many Catholic immigrants came to this area after the church communities were built. Some of the first German immigrants were the Sandshultes, Poppies, Dishlers, Hunts, Hessles, Bolanders, Vonbimels and Schemers, who were all hardworking craftsmen.

Loretto Lift-Up, Inc has sponsored Oktoberfest in Loretto since 1989 as a way to celebrate that German heritage, the harvest, and their community spirit and pride. They celebrate with food, crafts, pumpkins, community gatherings and more food! You don't have to be German to enjoy the festivities. Everyone is welcome!

RECIPE: Braised Chicken Thighs with Spinach and White Beans

8 chicken thighs • 1 medium onion chopped
2 garlic cloves smashed • 3 T olive oil • 1 T butter
1/2 cup white wine or chicken broth
1 t. each rosemary and thyme
2 15 oz cans white beans or 1/2lb dry white beans, cooked
1 10 oz package frozen chopped spinach
salt and pepper

In a large dutch oven heat olive oil and butter over medium high heat.


Sprinkle chicken thighs with salt and pepper and place skin side down in hot dutch oven.

Brown on both sides and remove from the pot, set aside.

Add onion and garlic to the pan and cook until softened, about 5 minutes. Deglaze the pot with the wine, making sure to scrap all of the brown bits off the bottom (they are delicious!)

Add in the beans, spinach, rosemary and thyme, salt and pepper to the pot. Nestle the chicken thighs skin side up in to the pan and add enough water (or chicken broth) to cover 2/3 of the chicken. Bring to a simmer, cover and reduce heat. Cook until the chicken pieces are cooked through, about 30 minutes. Serve and enjoy!





CLEVELAND CELEBRATES OLDEST HARDWARE STORE

Beaty Feed & Hardware first opened for business in 1936 as a feed store. The owners, Virgil and his wife Willie Beaty, started out selling feed in 100 pound bags. They first had to walk down to the railroad tracks and unload bulk feed, take it to the store, and put it into the 100-pound bags. In 1939, Beaty's moved their feed store to 650 Wildwood Avenue in Cleveland, and it remains at this location still today.

The first hardware items were added in 1952, when Willie would buy one

hammer, sell it, then buy two more, and that's how they began to build the hardware business. They also began selling electric water pumps in the '50s. As the demographics in the area changed from a totally agricultural economy to a manufacturing based economy, Beaty Feed and Hardware changed from a one-room feed store to a full line hardware store. Even today, lawn & garden, as well as specialty feeds, are an important part of the business. In 1968, their son, Clayton Beaty and his wife Judy, took ownership of the store. Clayton built up the store even more with gardening items like mulch, fertilizers and plants, as well as hardware items, and the store continued to build its name throughout Cleveland and the surrounding areas.



On June 1, 2005, Kenneth and Donna Malone took ownership and changed the name to Beaty True Value Hardware. Kenneth had worked for Beaty's Feed & Hardware Store for 31 years, and it was already his second home. Donna said she could remember her Papaw Miller taking her to buy different color baby chicks when she was a little girl in the '60s, and it just seemed natural that they continue at Beaty's. They kept most

of the items that sold good for the store; feed now sold in 50-pound bags, seedlings and plants are a must for spring seasonal sales, and they continue to add other items. You'll find pocket knives, such as Case brand, children's wagons, and other seasonal items like sleds and snow shovels, gloves, and lots of other winter items.

On April 1, 2012, the name changed to Beaty Hardware. In August 2017, the Collector's Corner was added; this is an antique and collectable section in the old front section of the store. This section is

filled with a variety of gifts, collectibles, farm-style decor and vintage treasures.

On Saturday, Oct. 5, Beaty's is having an 80th Anniversary Celebration. There will be special sales for this day only, and their antique and collectable vendors will be stocking up their booths with new items. Also, Kenneth Malone, store owner, has a special treat planned! He is making homemade ice cream in their vintage five-gallon hand crank ice cream freezer. Kenneth and Donna said, "Everyone is invited, so come on down, Saturday, Oct. 5th, and help Kenneth crank the ice cream freezer!"

They set up their vendor spaces with walls made from pallets, making it well organized and easy to browse and shop. April said they have the most compliments on how they staged and set up their walls, and how well the lighting shows up every space, as well as how clean the store stays and that it always has a fresh clean fragrance when entering. She said an organized and wellkept store helps customers to see everything in the booths, and they enjoy coming back again and again.

Once Again Vintage Treasures & Antiques has already had customers from numerous cities and states. Some have traveled from Atlanta, Nashville, Cookeville, Kentucky, Tennessee, South Carolina and even California. They have vendors from all over the South. Men, there's a man cave with tools, fishing equipment, signage, and other items for you to enjoy the hunt as well. There's just no prediction of what you might find at this store any given day. The prices are great, and that's one reason so many people return again. They have numerous store owners and vendors who shop with them as well.



The Brewers enjoy their picking outings and both look for their favorite collectibles and loved antiques while picking for their store. April is "nuts" over rolling pins. She told me she has over a hundred, and if she walks into an estate sale or market and there's a dozen rolling pins, she immediately knows exactly which one she has or does not have! She loves kitchen ware, including primitive, vintage and antique pieces. She likes '50s and '60s items like Hoosiers, vintage tables, red-checked tablecloths, painted handled tools and all the vintage kitchen finds you can still use or decorate with, especially rolling pins! She has

an eye for the glassware, particularly Depression glass in all colors, and she looks for glassware, dinnerware, and serving pieces that can be used for wedding receptions, parties, etc.

Jeff loves trains of all sizes, and kinds, the older, the more cars and accessories, the better. 


