1 pkg. angel food cake mix 1 (no. 2) can peach pie filling 1 pkg. vanilla pudding mix 1 c. heavy cream, whipped 2 c. milk

Prepare cake mix according to package directions. Bake in a 10-inch tube pan. Cool and remove from pan. Place on tray. Slice entire top from cake about an inch from the top. Hollow out center of cake, leaving about an inch base and sides. Prepare pudding mix using 2 cups of milk. Mix half the pie filling with pudding. Spoon into cavity of the cake. Replace top of cake. Fold in remaining pie filling into whipped cream. Frost cake with this mixture. Chill until ready to serve.







RECIPE: Buffalo Salad with Shoestring Fried Onions

1 large boneless skinless chicken breast 3/4 cup buttermilk • 1/2 cup panko bread crumbs ½ cup yellow cornmeal divided ½ cup buffalo wing sauce (I like Moore's) 1 small onion peeled and thinly sliced into rings ½ cup all purpose flour • 1 t . kosher salt • ½ t . pepper Vegetable oil for frying 4 cups chopped mixed lettuces (such as romaine spinach, etc.) 1 roma tomato sliced • 1/2 avocado sliced 1/4 cup shredded mozzarella

Dressing:

½ cup plain yogurt • 3 T light mayo • 2 T buttermilk 1 T fresh parsley • ½ t . dill weed • ½ t . onion powder ½ t. garlic powder • ½ t. salt • ¼ t. pepper • 1 t. lemon juice

Preheat the oven to 425 degrees. Slice the chicken breast into 4 strips. Submerge the chicken in the buttermilk, making sure to coat. In a shallow dish, mix together 1/4 cup of the cornmeal and the panko bread crumbs and season with 1 t. salt and ¼ t. pepper. Coat each chicken strip in the bread crumb mixture and place them onto a greased baking sheet.

Spray the strips liberally with cooking spray and bake for 10 minutes, turning halfway through, until chicken reaches 165 degrees.

Meanwhile, in a shallow dish mix together the remaining cornmeal, flour and ½ t. salt and 1/4 t. pepper. Toss the onion slices in the flour mixture, making sure to separate the rings as you toss. Heat about ½ an inch of vegetable oil in a skillet until the oil shimmers.

Add the onions to the oil and fry until golden brown, about 7 minutes.

Remove with a slotted spoon and drain on paper towels. Combine all of the dressing ingredients in a blender or food processer and blend until smooth. Taste and adjust seasonings if necessary.

In two large bowls, divide the lettuce mix, top with tomatoes, avocado and mozzarella cheese. Place 2 chicken strips on top of lettuce bed and top each with fried onions. Serve with dressing on top!

For the Love (and Luck) of the Orish

St. Patrick's Day isn't as big of a celebration in the South as in other parts of the world, but most of us do wear a bit of green on March 17 - maybe for luck, and maybe to avoid getting pinched. This early springtime holiday seems like the perfect time to add a bit of green to our homes as well, doesn't it?

Most of us know the basic history of March 17: St. Patrick was a 5th century Romano-British Christian missionary and Bishop in Ireland. By the 7th century he was acknowledged as the patron saint of Ireland and March 17 is the widely accepted date of his death, when we recognize him and Ireland with a celebration that typically includes green....shamrocks, leprechauns, clothing, beer, and more. So what can we do to incorporate vintage elements on St. Patrick's Day?

1. Salt and Pepper Figurine-Style Shakers

We can credit the 20th century with countless pairs of novelty salt and pepper shakers in all shapes and sizes, including all things Irish. Here are a few samples of what you may find in estate sales, thrift stores, auctions and

antique stores (if you're lucky.) Can't find any of these sweet vintage figurines? You're in luck - there are several manufacturers still making kitschy retro-inspired sets; you'll find them in department stores or online. Care for them as any other vintage ceramics - handwash when needed and allow to air dry; store them out of direct sunlight to avoid fading.

2. Irish Linens

For something a little more subtle and refined, how about

some Irish linens or lace as a tip o' the hat to the fair isle? Irish linen has long been held in high regard. Spun and woven from 100% flax fibers for thousands of years, Irish linen production became more organized by the 15th century. Nowadays, it is often associated with damask patterns woven into the fabric crated into tablecloths, napkins, runners and towels. Irish linen is typically coarser and denser than other European linens, and is coveted for making breathable, and high-quality summer clothing.











You may also find Irish lace on vintage table linens. Popularized in the 1850s, it was often hand-made at home and in workhouses by women and children in Ireland, to adorn wedding and christening gowns of wealthy Europeans.

It's important to care for your vintage linens properly: wash by hand or on a gentle cycle and allow them to line-dry, then press it while it's damp to crisp perfection; avoid using starch unless you're going to use them and re-wash them immediately. Store out of direct sunlight and in dry conditions to avoid mildew.

3. Pops of Green In Your Home

If you're looking for some green with more "staying power" than leprechauns and shamrocks, you can just add some pops of spring green here and there in your decor. Rich green soda bottles make great vases or decor; a boxwood wreath adds just the right pop of green color, and will last well into the warm months ahead. Soft vintage planters (empty or filled with a favorite houseplant) can also strike just the right note as we welcome spring into our homes.

On dining tables, we're longtime fans of Majolica dishes and we home in on any green and white textured plates, bowls and vases anytime we find them in the wild.

4. Vintage Jewelry

If you want to avoid the dreaded pinching on March 17, look for a vintage piece of jewelry to add the requisite green to your attire. Snag a charming cloisonné enamel pin or pendant for a necklace, or splurge on something with jade or an emerald. If you're truly fortunate, you'll luck up on a 4-leaf clover sealed forever to wear on a necklace or charm bracelet.

No matter what you do, be sure you do something that will bring you a bit of good fortune and welcome Spring this month!

RECIPE: Spring Parmesan Pasta

1 pound corkscrew shaped pasta
4 slices bacon, chopped
2 tablespoons butter
1 medium onion, minced
1 pound fresh swiss chard or spinach
2 cups fresh peas, or 1-10 oz. bag frozen peas
½ cup finely shredded Parmesan cheese

Bring a large pot of salted water to boil and cook the pasta per the package directions.

Drain the pasta but reserve 1 cup of the cooking water for the sauce.

While the pasta is cooking, heat a very large skillet or heavy wide pot over medium to medium high heat and add the bacon to the pan. Cook the bacon until it is crisp and remove it to some paper towels to drain.



Add the butter to the bacon grease in the pan and then add in the onion. While the onion is cooking, remove the stems from the Swiss chard, and then chop the leaves and the stems separately. Add the stems to the pan with the onion and cook for 3-4 minutes or until the onion and the Swiss chard stems begin to soften. Add in the green leaves and the peas and continue to cook, over medium heat until the greens have wilted and the peas are tender, another 3-5 minutes.

Add the bacon, Parmesan and pasta to the pan and stir to combine everything loosely together. Add in about ½ of the pasta water to the pan and continue to stir until a creamy sauce forms. If the pasta still seems a little dry, add the remaining pasta water.

Sprinkle with more cheese and serve immediately.

Tip: Swiss Chard is my favorite of the leafy greens and comes with a crisp stem that is similar in texture to celery. Unlike other greens, this stem is delicious to eat!

RECIPE: Pimento Cheese Tomato Pie

2 large, ripe tomatoes (any color will work)
salt
crust for single crust pie
1 1/2 cups pimento cheese
basil leaves (optional)

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees. Line a large plate with several layers of paper towels. Slice the tomatoes into 1/8-inch thick rounds. Salt one side of the tomato slices and spread them on a single layer on top of the paper towels. Salt the other side. Let the tomatoes stand for fifteen minutes then flip them over and allow to stand for an additional fifteen minutes.

While the tomatoes are draining, par-bake the pie crust. Roll the crust into a 12-inch circle and press into a 9-inch pie plate or deep dish tart pan, crimping the edges if using a pie plate.

Line with foil and fill with pie weights or dry beans. Bake for ten minutes.

After the tomatoes have drained for 30 minutes, gently press a paper towel on top to remove any excess moisture on top. Spread 1/2 cup of pimento cheese in the bottom of the pie crust. Top that with half of the tomato slices, then another half cup of the pimento cheese, the remaining tomatoes, and the remaining pimento cheese. Bake the pie for 25-35 minutes, until the crust is golden and the cheese is lightly browned and bubbly. Top with desired amount of torn basil, if desired. Allow to stand for ten minutes before slicing and serving.


