





RECIPE: Slow Cooker Pork Shoulder with Peach-White Wine Sauce

For the Pork Shoulder 4-5 pound pork shoulder

1/3 cup brown sugar 1/3 cup kosher salt

For the Peach Sauce

2 cups sliced peaches, frozen or fresh, cut into 1-inch pieces
2 cups dry white wine or Vermouth
2 1/2 tablespoons rice wine vinegar
1/2 cup granulated sugar
2 sprigs thyme
1 tablespoon grainy mustard



Rub the pork: Combine the sugar and salt in a small bowl. Cut a crosshatch pattern into the fat cap of the pork. Rub the sugar/salt mixture all over the pork. Wrap tightly in plastic wrap.

Place on a large plate and refrigerate overnight.

Cook the pork: remove the pork from the plastic. Brush away excess rub. Place into a 4 or 5-quart slow cooker. Cook on low for 8 hours.

Remove the pork to a cutting board and tent with foil. Pour the juices into a measuring cup or fat separator. Skim off the fat or use a spoon to remove the fat from the juices. Reserve 2 tablespoons juice. Place the juice, peaches, wine or Vermouth, 2 tablespoons of the vinegar, sugar, and thyme into a small saucepan. Bring to a simmer over medium-high heat and cook until reduced to a thick sauce, about 20-30 minutes. Remove from the heat and stir in the

remaining vinegar and the mustard. Serve the pork topped with the peach sauce. Save extra pork for other uses.

Notes: It's easy to adapt this recipe to the pressure cooker function on your Instant Pot. Just cut the pork into 4-6 pieces before applying the rub. Place in the Instant Pot and set to the "meat" setting for 45 minutes. Allow the Instant Pot to depressurize naturally. Shred the meat then follow the directions as listed to make the sauce.







RECIPE: Easy Sausage Balls from Scratch

2 cups all-purpose flour • 1 tablespoon baking powder 3/4 teaspoon salt

1/2 cup (1 stick) unsalted butter, cut into cubes and chilled 1 pound breakfast sausage (mild or hot, your choice) 1 pound cheddar cheese (2 8-ounce blocks), grated • milk

Preheat the oven to 375 degrees. If desired, spray 2 sheet pans with cooking spray (I actually never bother). In a large bowl, stir together the flour, baking powder, and salt. Using a pastry blender or your fingertips, work the butter into the flour mixture until the mixture resembles coarse crumbs. Add the sausage and cheese to the bowl along with a couple of tablespoons of milk. Using your



hands, work the ingredients together until well-combined, adding milk a tablespoon at a time to moisten the mixture so that you can get all the dry flour (you can also use a stand mixer with the paddle attachment to do this, but I just prefer to use my hands).

Portion the sausage ball mixture into tablespoon size pieces (I use a cookie scoop to do this) and roll into balls using your palms before placing them onto the baking sheets.

Bake the sausage balls until lightly browned, about 20-25 minutes. Stack on paper towels for a few minutes to absorb excess butter.

Serve immediately or at room temperature.





For the Love of Little Drawers

Whether it's a simple wood recipe card holder, a sewing machine drawer or a massive library card file, there's something almost magical about little drawers. Maybe it's the appeal of bringing organization to our things - and lives - this time of year. Let's explore the history of things with drawers, where to find them and how to incorporate them into your home.

A brief history of drawers.

The history of drawers isn't as old as we might think; they date back only to the 17th century. Up until that time, items were stored in cabinets behind doors. Once dovetail joinery and other woodworking techniques and innovations were introduced, drawers picked up steam and they're still one of the most popular ways to organize and store all kinds of goods at home and in the workplace.

Sewing machine cabinets with drawers were introduced in the late 1700s. File drawers and filing cabinets came along in the late 1800s. Recipe cards (and boxes to hold them) came about in the early 1900s, after standardized measurements became the norm.

And my personal favorite? The library file cabinet, which was the brainchild of Ezra Abbott in 1860 and began to be adopted by libraries a few years later, just in time for Melvil Dewey to formulate his system for categorizing and cataloging

books in the Amherst College Library in 1876. The last library card was printed in 2015.

The physical card cases range from small 2-drawer units to 100+ drawer cabinets. The most standard configuration is 18-drawers (three rows of six drawers) that could be stacked together. Globe-Wernicke was a leading maker of card

file drawers along with many other office organizing cabinets - barrister's cases with sliding glass doors, accounting cabinets that were vertical and allowed ledgers to be stored upright, and of course standard filing cabinets.

Where can I find old drawers?

It's relatively easy to find simple single drawer items like recipe boxes and old sewing machine drawers at flea markets, estate sales and vintage and antique shops.

Card catalogs were often relegated to storage and sold off for pennies when libraries underwent remodels. For a while, these beautiful cabinets were plentiful and cheap. When a love of academia-related items emerged a decade or so ago, these cast-offs became coveted treasures,



and they now fetch hundreds if not thousands of dollars, depending on age, size and condition.

Fair warning - before you gleefully snag a big, gorgeous old cabinet, consider how you'll maneuver it into your

home. The largest

and oldest cabinets are hefty, to say the least. Newer systems incorporated plastic into the drawers, substantially reducing the weight. We have a 60-drawer wood cabinet; even with all the drawers out, it's difficult to move, especially up and down stairs.



Apothecary and card catalog cabinets add an instant vibe to your decor, and they may get by on "good looks and charm." But most of us need and want our furniture to function. So consider using larger cabinets as a wine case (measure first, but many of them will hold a standard bottle of wine.) For the seamstress, artist or crafter, a multi-drawer cabinet is immensely practical and will hold your items in style.

Single drawers can be used to create table displays, hold keys, bottles and jars, or even small potted plants in. your entryway, kitchen or bathroom. We have a wood whisky bottle box with a sliding top that holds our television remotes on our covered porch and keeps them safe from the occasional blowing rain - since it's a new-ish box (and can be replaced), we aren't too worried


about preserving it.

Caring for your vintage and antique drawers

As with any wood items, if you want them to last, keep them away from moisture and direct sunlight. If they were coated with shellac, you may need to eventually re-finish it in order to preserve its color and patina. We personally

don't recommend painting old catalogs. But if yours is beyond redemption, painting is an option if refinishing is not.
