For the Love of Old Time Pieces

Time has sprung forward again...but how do you keep time? Most of us rely on a phone or other digital device to tell us what time it is, but what about the time-keepers of old? From sundials and hour glasses to wind-up clocks, we've kept track of time without technology for...well, for a long time.

The passing of time has been measured and marked by many devices, starting with ancient sundials that appeared in Egypt and Mesopotamia around 3500 BC. Water clocks used the inflow and outflow of water between bowls to measure time in ancient Babylon, Egypt and Persia around 1600 BC. Candle clocks measured time as the wax melted past notches on the candle. The hourglass was invented in France in the 8th century and was one of the few ways to reliably measure time on ships.

The first mechanical clocks were invented in Europe around 1500 and in 1656 by monks. The pendulum clock was invented by Christiaan Huygens and the earliest versions of pendulum clocks were surprisingly accurate, erring by less than a minute day.

Grandfather clocks in tall cases were made possible by William Clement who developed a "seconds" pendulum that was 39 inches long and vibrated through a small arc.

Mantel or shelf clocks were developed in the mid-18th century and are still traditionally placed on a mantel or shelf in the home. Torsion clocks



protected by a glass dome, often placed on shelves or mantels for display and to keep time.

The first timepiece compact enough to be carried was the pocket watch by Peter Henlein in Germany in the early 1500s. 1510. In 1868, Patek Philippe created what is thought to be the first wristwatch

for Countess Koscowicz of Hungary, and that advancement made timepieces become

popular as a piece of functional jewelry.

Where to find old clocks and watches?

Like all antiques, time pieces can be found in antique and vintage stores. Online marketplaces like Etsy and eBay also have scads of time pieces for every era and taste, from sundials and hourglasses to atomic wall clocks and traditional grandfather clocks. Estate sales and auctions often have large and small timekeeping pieces in the items up for sale. How to care for an old clock or watch?

Older time pieces, while well-made, need to be maintained. Consult with a jeweler or watch repair professional to fix and maintain your antique time piece and keep it in tip-top working shape. Metals should be kept polished to avoid pitting from tarnish. Wood cases should be kept dusted with a barely damp microfiber cloth. If the finish is wax, an occasional re-waxing is in order. If it needs to be oiled, use a citrus oil (lemon or orange) to restore its luster.

How to upcycle an old time piece?

Whether you want to paint your grandfather clock, or you want to repurpose an old watch or time piece, there are ways to keep old treasures even when they no longer function.

Here are some inspirational photos of clocks that have been updated with paint.

You can also find old watch parts re-used and repurposed into one-of-a-kind earrings, necklaces,

and more. And old watch faces can be used to create an oversized, whimsical clock.

Whatever you do, take care of your old time pieces. Find ways to keep them ticking and keeping track of time.







RECIPE: Fluffy Banana Pudding

3/4 cup plus 3 tablespoons sugar
3 tablespoons cornstarch
1/4 teaspoon kosher salt
2 large eggs
1 large egg yolk
2 cups whole milk
3 tablespoons unsalted butter, cut into 6 pieces
and chilled
1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract
1 box vanilla wafers
4-6 just ripe bananas (yellow, not brown!)
1 tablespoon lemon juice

Combine 3/4 cup sugar, cornstarch, and kosher salt in a medium saucepan. Add the eggs and egg yolk and whisk until well combined. Slowly whisk in the milk until well combined. Cook over medium-low heat until thickened and about 175 degrees. Remove from heat and whisk in the butter, one piece at a time. Add vanilla and whisk to combine. Use a spatula to scrape into a bowl. Press wax or parchment paper down over the surface and refrigerate

1 1/2 cups heavy whipping cream

Slice the bananas into 1/4 inch slices. Toss with the lemon juice in a small bowl and set aside. Using an electric mixer, whip the cream with the remaining sugar until it reaches soft peaks.

until completely chilled.

Carefully fold 2/3 of the whipped cream into the chilled pudding until light and fluffy.

Place a small amount of the pudding into the bottom of a medium bowl. Follow with a layer of vanilla wafers and a layer of banana. Top with 1/3 of the pudding. Repeat twice,

finishing with a layer of pudding. Top with remaining whipped cream. Refrigerate until ready to serve.




