I love MTSU like any other proud parent, but today let's talk about blue and white. Specifically the rich blues and white tones that we often associate with Chinoiserie and

Asian-inspired decor.

Blue and white: It's a crisp, classic combo that has stood the test of time. With the Grand Millenial trend taking root, it's only logical that Asian-inspired motifs and colors will have a renewed surge in popularity.







Look for "Something Fishy" in Two New Locations

You can now look for new, used and vintage fishing stuff in the 'SOMETHING FISHY' booths at two new locations. SOMETHING FISHY, owned by Ronnie Wood, has been inside of Vintage and More on the Blvd., 3874 Dayton Blvd in Red Bank, Tenn., for seven years. Recently, Ronnie expanded his FISHY business inside of The Robin's Nest located at 4039 Cloud Springs Rd in Ringgold, Ga.

In February, an opportunity opened for Ronnie to set up a display inside of East Town Antique Mall at 1165 Slater Road in the East Ridge Antique District behind the Cracker Bar-

rel. His display case is limited to vintage lures and reels - Mitchell 300, 302, 306, 308, & 310. Also, D. A. M. Quick 110, 220, & 300; Orvis 100 and a Zebco Cardinal 4. Also available at East Town Antique Mall are split bamboo fly rods, casting rods, steel pole rods in a variety of brands. These are mostly from late '50s, '60s and early '70s. The booths located at Vintage and More on the Blvd and The Robin's Nest feature a large variety of vintage rods and reels, huge amount of lures in all sizes and makes, bobbers, tackle boxes, wall art decor', memorabilia and much, much more.

Ronnie's interest in fishing and collecting tackle began as a young man, not only fishing side-by-side with his dad, but helping his dad, the late J.T. Boyd, rebuild and repair reels. They would purchase used rod and reels in estate sales, close out sales and other places, repair if needed, clean and freshen them up, and set up at flea markets to sell them on weekends. Parts from the used reels were often needed to repair a customer's reel

when new parts were not available. The business snowballed making it necessary for them to purchase extra parts and equipment to have on hand. By this time Ronnie was collecting a huge variety of antique and vintage fishing tackle to sell. When Ronnie's dad passed in 2004, Ronnie put everything in storage. He just wasn't able to continue repairing and rebuilding fishing reels for several

years. In 2016 he started rebuilding and retailing some of his oldest antique and vintage reels. He has collected an immense amount of tackle and fishing equipment

including vintage items that make excellent man cave selections. This

collection for retail includes wall hangers, signage, metal, plastic and fiberglass tackle boxes which are often used as small tool boxes or repurposed into items such as lamps, storage for collectibles and other decor' purposes.

Ronnie's prices are very reasonable, and his products are in


good shape when you purchase them. Some of his oldest lures from the mid '60s and up may start at \$5 up to \$50; the older the lure the more valuable it becomes given the brand, age and condition. Vintage reels are often sold between \$25 to \$40; older fly rods may start as low as \$50 and may go as high as \$200. Old spinning reels, if rare and fine quality, particularly Swiss made and all metal, sometime sell for \$150 or better.

For the young and older kids alike, try your luck at winning a prize! Ronnie keeps bubblegum/prize machines filled with fishing memorabilia; lures valued at .25 to \$1, and coupons for tee

shirts or discounts. Everything is valued from \$1.50 to \$5 with an occasional \$10 item, and it only costs .25 to fish from the machine.

Check out SOMETHING FISHY at all three locations, and if looking for something specific that they don't have, leave your name, number and item for the owner to give to Ronnie Wood, he may just have it in storage.

Bray Oaks Forge Tanasi Grand Opening

Bray Oaks Forge Tanasi will be holding it's Premier Grand Opening, Saturday, April 20 from 1 to 4 p.m. This new antique store in Historic Downtown Etowah, Tenn., will feature antiques and primitives, as well as custom made art by the owner, William (Will) McAlister. Will McAlister specializes in blacksmith artwork, where he custom designs and recreates historic weapons such as tomahawks, fixed blade knives in numerous designs, gunstock war clubs and other items, some with very rare wood handles; one of which the wood is dated back thousands of years.

Will's first interest was sparked when his dad brought the family from Memphis to Pigeon Forge, Tenn., and he visited a blacksmith shop where he could purchase a gold horseshoe with his name stamped on it. He started collecting hand forged items, as well as many other primitives and antiques by the time he was 13, and the passion grew as he got older. In high school, he took art and mechanical drafting classes, and they both influenced him immensely. He has loved history and early handmade tools and items

used in the past. He particularly liked learning about items that were made and used by Indian tribes for battle and hunting. This is where he learned about the peace pipe tomahawks and the gunstock war clubs. He has some amazing ones he has made, and they can be purchased at his shop. The gunstock war clubs are very unique; they have an effigy the head is carved like an animal head with eyes and a nose.

Will moved to Maryville, Tenn., in 1991, where he worked in a local industry and enjoyed picking, collecting and enjoying festivals in Southeast Tennessee. Some 20 years later, his weekends





began to fill up

with festivals and shows, where he would exhibit and demonstrate his work. He has taken several classes at the well known and affluent John C Campbell Folks School in Brasstown, N.C. He studied blacksmithing under Ryan M Johnson (RMJ), a very well known artist who taught classes on making tomahawks and knives. Will has done his own research and being an artist, he is very gifted with custom designing different items from railroad spikes and other metal specimens. He loves to re-purpose things. He might find a very small intricate item, and immediately envisions it with other items - wood, metal or stones maybe, and then customizes a piece of art, often framed for hanging. Will did demonstrations of his blacksmithing at Sequoyah's birthplace for five years, and has set up at many festivals and demonstrated blacksmithing.

Two years ago, Will started designing and making Raku pottery pieces. Now he has added two kilns for future classes, and is in the process of formulating a glaze for other kinds of pottery. Classes are available in blacksmithing; you may register how to forge horse shoe knives, cleavers, railroad spikes knives or tomahawks, as well as

an introduction to blacksmithing. Call 865-318-1964 for more information and scheduling a class for a group or yourself. Will's daughters are both artists also. Bray makes custom-designed copper bracelets, and Taylor works with beads and natures elements such as driftwood to make one-of-a-kind pieces of art. His next phase will be an art gallery; monthly art events will be held and artisans will be able to rent booths to demonstrate and sell their art.

19TH ANNUAL CLINCH RIVER SPRING ANTIQUE FESTIVAL

The 19th Annual Clinch River Spring Antique Festival will be Saturday, May 4 in Downtown Clinton, Tenn. The Spring Festival will again be paired between antique dealers and artisans this May. Dealers selling their antique wares will continue to set up on Market Street in the Historic Downtown District on Friday and Saturday, while artisans will be able to show on Saturday, May 4 only, and their booths will be on Main Street. The antique dealers will begin setting up between 8:30 and 9 a.m. Friday morning, and the festival will open at 12 noon till 6 p.m.

Saturday's festival will be 9-5 for both artisans and antiques. Vendors are encouraged to apply for the spring and fall festival, and receive a discount for reserving booths for both. This event traditionally attracts over 10,000 shoppers. Their goal for 2024 is to break a new record for both spring and fall festivals. Many stores will be open until 8 p.m. on Friday night for extra shopping.

Clinton is one of the largest antique enthusiast towns in America, and they give a very strong support to the arts. Three art festivals are held in Clinton

each year, and the historic downtown district features different artisan store fronts throughout the year. The hosts for the festival, Historic Downtown Clinton, affectionately calls their juried show of one-of-a-kind arts, 'Heirlooms in Waiting on Main Street.' These unique custom made and hand crafted items will be the antiques and treasures sought after in years to come. Plan to come early on Saturday to enjoy shopping on both Main and Market Street.

The antique festival routinely features over 100 dealers, with lots of antique furniture of solid wood, and a huge variety of items, from small and large tables, dining sets, hutches, Hoosiers, desks, corner cabinets - lots of high quality antiques and primitives. They have a lot of vintage household items, farm tools, antique smalls and collectibles. This year's spring event has already accepted a couple of new dealers. One is Straw Plains Pickers who specializes in antique and vintage furniture, small tools, household items and collectibles. Another new dealer is Bent Oak Antique & Curiosities; they feature furniture, home decor, textiles and art.







All dealers have a criteria they must meet, and each must send pictures and descriptions of their products and a picture of their set up. Once approved, Executive Director, Katherine Birkbeck, will contact each of you. Artisans are accepted based on the type of art they create. The list of categories could be apothecary such as hand-poured candles, handmade soaps, balms, lotions, bath/body and herbal products. Clay/pottery products such as original clay, ceramic, porcelain, stone or earthen ware. Digital art-two dimensional works that the artist has manipu-

lated the image using a computer; drawing and print making could be original drawings made with pen, pencil, charcoal, pastels, chalk and other. Printmaking may include silk printing, etching, engraving and other. Edibles include handmade food items that are pre-packaged and not made onsite. Some other art categories include fiber/textiles, furniture, glass, jewelry, metal, mixed media, living botanicals, painting, photography, wood and sculpture and other art. Their website has a very detailed list you may view.

There's always live entertainment, and lots of tasty foods, plus there's dozens of local antique shops, decor, boutiques, art and so much more to browse and shop. The Historic Downtown Clinton is a non-profit group comprised of citizens, business owners, gov-

ernment officials and friends who are dedicated to revitalization and preservation by promoting the historic downtown, and furthering the community's economy and preserving it's heart and soul. They belong to MainStreet Tennessee as well as MainStreet National. They have already received several grants, one is an improvement grant that is allowing them to work on five buildings at this time.

For those who want to apply for booths for both spring and fall, visit their website by April 15, and if you want to pick up an application for the Clinton Fall Antique Festival to be held on October 4-5, 2024, visit the Historic Downtown Clinton

booth while at the Annual Clinch River Spring Festival May 3.4. Mark your calendar and make plan to spend both days in Clinton!


