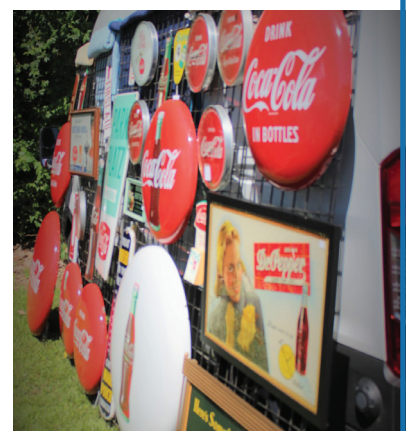

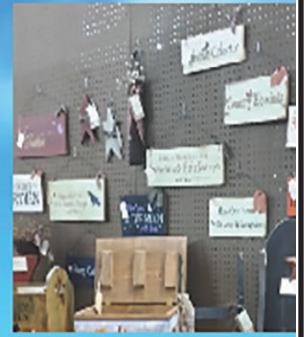

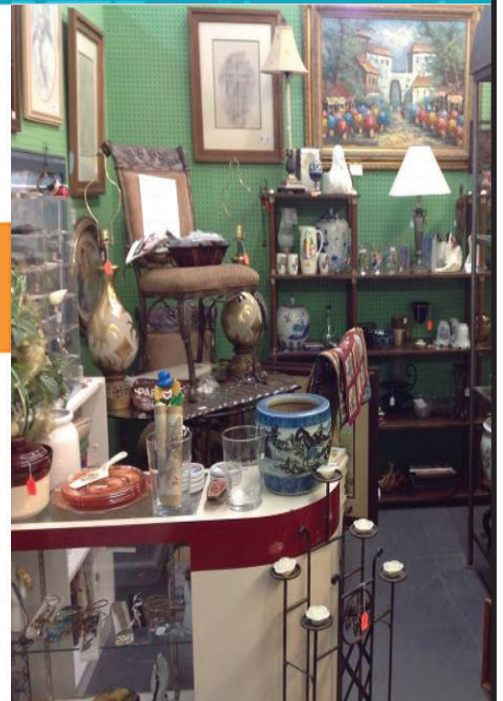

RECIPE: EASY COCONUT SHRIMP WITH PIÑA COLADA SAUCE

1 pound medium (26/30) shrimp, peeled and deveined
1/2 cup all-purpose flour • 2 beaten eggs
1/2 cup panko crumbs • 1/2 cup shredded coconut
salt and pepper • olive oil spray or cooking spray

For the Piña Colada Sauce

1/4 cup sour cream • 1/4 cup diced pineapple
1 tablespoon granulated sugar
1 tablespoon rum (I used coconut rum) or pineapple juice



To make the piña colada sauce, stir the ingredients together in a small bowl. Cover and refrigerate until ready to use.

Place a rack in the center of the oven; place a baking sheet in the oven and preheat the oven to 450 degrees.

Place a cooling rack on another baking sheet.

Set up a breading station: one bowl with flour, one with beaten eggs, and one with panko and coconut. Salt and pepper each bowl so that you get good seasoning for your shrimp.

Dip each shrimp into flour, then egg, then the coconut mixture. Place on the cooling rack.

When all of the shrimp have been breaded, spray the preheated baking sheet with olive oil spray or cooking spray. Place the shrimp on the baking sheet and spray the tops with olive oil spray or cooking spray. Bake for 8 minutes.

Flip the shrimp and spray the opposite side. Bake for an additional 7 minutes. Serve immediately with piña colada sauce.

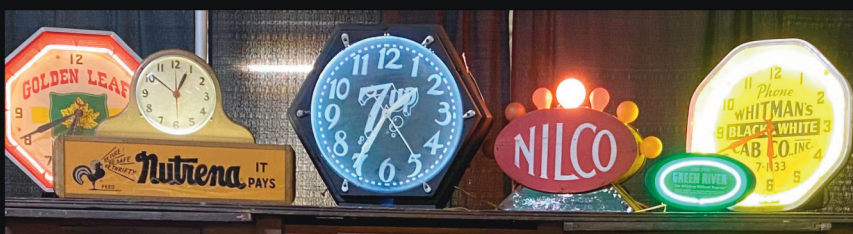

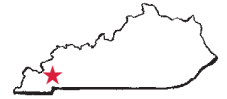

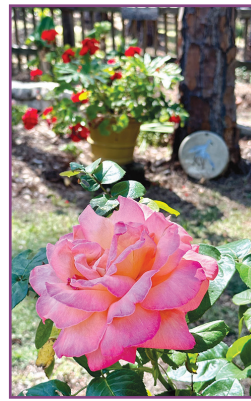


LETTER FROM THE PUBLISHER

Hello readers, I hope you've had a lovely spring so far, and have been out shopping our wide variety of advertisers, and attending events on our calendar. It finally walked out, and we were able to see it was very large, and looked like

a mama that had nursing cubs. We yelled and banged on things, and she finally ran off into the undergrowth. How exciting! The next morning we saw she had clawed the bark off the dead pine tree that had been struck by lightning the previous year, that also killed my minivan after it exited the tree root. There must have been termites or insects she was dining on under the bark!

Time to head back to the farm to do more work there, and Busy Bee deliveries. Until next month...

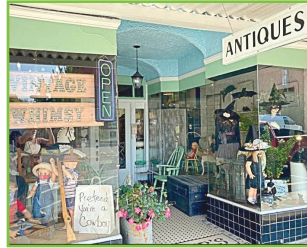

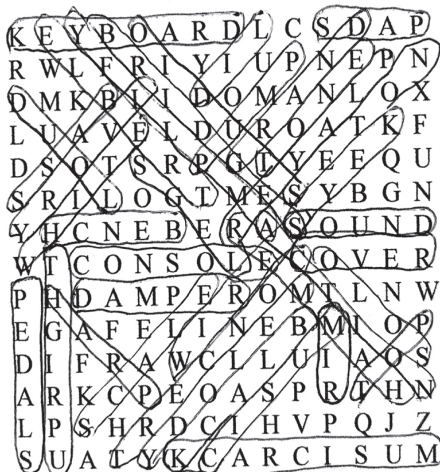

This is breaking my heart. I have more questions than I have answers. I am so so sorry to only be able to give you such a short time to make decisions. I hope you will forgive me. I am praying for each of you. I am more than grateful that this precious store did not only give me "customers" it gave me friendships, deep and meaningful friendships. I love you all dearly. As I was grieving all of this news, the Lord quietly told me that the ministry that He allowed me to do one on one with our vendors and customers would continue, just without the distraction of the store. That quieted my spirit

and I came into agreement with Him. Yes, Lord, as I am led and my health allows, I can not wait to be others one on one without the distraction of running a business. You all have added so much to our journey. I couldn't have done this without you.

Despite all of the hard news these past two weeks, I see evidence of God working in everything. For some reason He is allowing this to happen. Please pray that I would run the race He has marked out for me with perseverance, keeping my eyes on Jesus the author and perfecter of my faith. The above information was revealed by wonderful doctors, now when you add the Creator of the world into this.... well, Let's see what He will do. He knows me by name. He knows you by name. He is God ... There is nothing impossible for Him. AND if He is for us, who can be against us. We are in a win win situation. I have the living God through the Holy Spirit inhabiting me, guiding me, directing me, protecting me. Only God knows the day that I will exit planet earth. The moment that happens I will be with Him for eternity. We truly value your prayers and humbly ask for His will to be done.

If I can help you during this transition, please let me know. Andrew and I will do our best to accommodate.

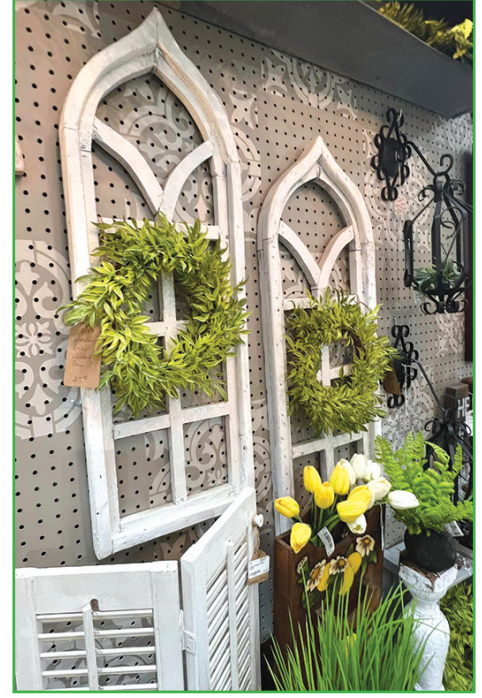

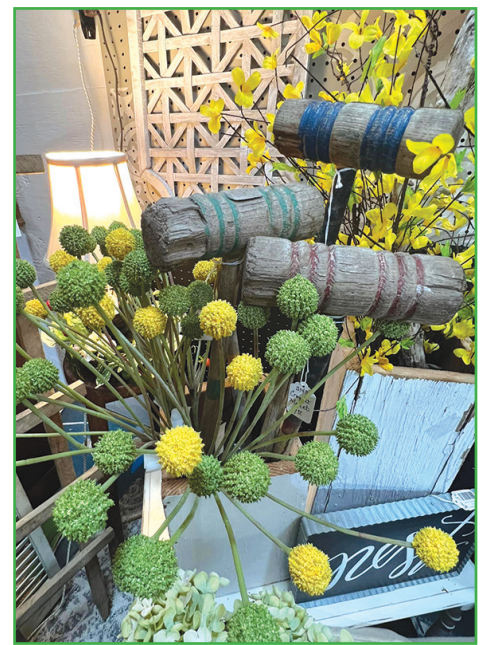

For the Love of Vintage Table Linens

Bare tabletops are low-maintenance and easy cleanup...but they're also a tad boring. Our mothers and grandmothers knew that a tablecloth not only added protection for their table, but it adds a layer of color and texture to the table, and they were willing to launder and press linen tablecloths as part of the weekly wash load. Eventually "wrinkle free" polyester won its way into the hearts and homes of homemakers, with stain resistance and no ironing required.

But there's a charm and beauty in the sturdy, colorful table linens of the 19th century. Let's take a trip down memory lane and explore the history and evolution of "clothing" your table.

A brief history of tablecloths

Most historical timelines point to 10e AD as the first mention of a table covering. By the Middle Ages, tablecloths signaled your status - pure white cloths were a sign of wealth, while rough and unbleached hemp cloth were found in less-wealthy homes.

By the 18th century, wealthy homes stored their linens in a linen "press" cabinet, often placed in a prominent location in the home.

In the 20th century, color entered the tablecloth scene with hand-embroidered linens followed by vibrant printed patterns by manufacturers such as Martex. Square, rectangle, oval and round shapes, in a rainbow of colors, you'll find a tablecloth that not only fits your table, but your favorite colors and season or holiday.

Where to find vintage tablecloths?

Auctions, antique shops, and online platforms such as Etsy and eBay are great sources



As with all vintage linens, take care to not weaken the fibers when trying to clean old stains. Products like OxiClean work on most stains, but for more delicate items, try a gentle detergent such as "Retro Clean". Don't wring items but gently remove excess water, rinse well and allow to air dry. Mildew problems? Sunlight can eradicate them. Helpful hint: iron them when they're still slightly damp - they crisp up without adding any starch. We don't recommend starching that are being pressed and stored for long periods - the starch will eventually weaken the fibers. Another great reason to use your vintage items, instead of just storing them.

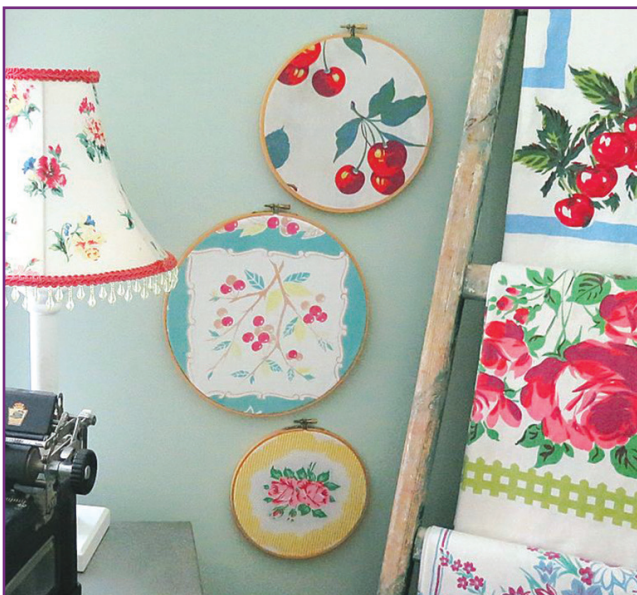
What if your favorite pattern is too far gone to use as a tablecloth, get creative: find good sections and use them to make pillows, table runners, and even purses so they'll live on for another generation.

Most sell for under \$100, but occasionally one will command a price of a few hundred dollars. Find the perfect one but it has a stain? Don't give up on it before you give it a good cleaning.

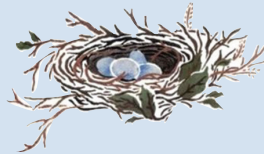
